

Alcohol Information

The rules regarding alcohol permits have recently been changed. I will apply for the permit for you but the permit is in your name since you will be hosting the event. The liability is of course with me, which is covered by my One Million Dollar Liquor Liability Insurance Policy. Our contract shows that we are serving alcohol; which absolves you from any liability.

The ABC commission has made a few more requirements of permit holders so anyone serving alcohol must provide me with the following information so that I can get the permit to you. I will need *full name, driver license number and state it is in, social security number, a copy of the contract (lease agreement) you have with the event site and I must provide the commission with a copy of your criminal record check*. You can get this at any court house. The clerk will pull up your name and pertinent information and give you a certified copy of the record they find.

The request for a permit must be sent in *three weeks* before the event date to allow proper processing time. Please make sure you get the information to me *ASAP*. Event sites will not let us serve alcohol unless we have this permit. If you have any questions please feel free to call me, 704-823-7806.
